FEW FACTS

In India, 80% plastic consumption is discarded as waste.

 Our country generates 25940 tonnes of plastic waste daily; 40% remains uncollected.

A plastic bottle takes 450-1000 years to decompose

• Single use plastic ...candy wrapper, tobacco,, soap, shampoo remain uncollected

• Nearly 50% of plastic waste are single use products ...bottles, bags, packaging, straw, spoons, forks

• In the last 70 years, 8.3 billion tonnes of plastic has been produced, 6.3 billion tonnes has been discarded
